2. IMDS Release 8.0 User Migration started

The IMDS Release 8.0 Early Adopter suppliers and OEMs recently completed a week of successful IMDS 8.0 trial, so on June 17th, 2013 the IMDS OEM users (car/truck manufacturers) were migrated to IMDS Release 8.0.

IMDS automotive supplier user migration has commenced in waves, with the first small batch migrated Wednesday, June 19th, 2013. Five more waves have since migrated with only minor issues, and IMDS users will continue to be migrated until all users have moved to exclusive use of IMDS Release 8.0.

- 1. All New IMDS company registrations are now implemented in IMDS Release 8.0.
- 2. At the request of some Asian OEMs and to optimize support at the regional IMDS Service Desks, companies based in Southeast Asia will migrate later in the migration process.

3. IMDS Release 8.0 User Migration process

The starting point for all IMDS use remains www.mdsystem.com. Until you are migrated, please continue to use the link to Classic IMDS 7.2. When you log in, the system will check whether your company has been migrated to IMDS Release 8.0. If not, the log-in works as always. If your company has been migrated, you will see a notification. Once notified, you cannot continue to use the IMDS Release 7.2 link. Please use the IMDS Release 8.0 link instead. After clicking this link you must log-in again. Your user ID and password for IMDS Release 8.0 are identical to the ones used in IMDS Release 7.2.

During the transition period, some companies will use Release 7.2, and some will use Release 8.0:

- 1. Companies not yet migrated continue to use only IMDS Release 7.2.
- 2. Companies once migrated will only use the new IMDS Release 8.0.



Migration will proceed over a period of several weeks. Leveraging the learning from the early adopter experience, we will define the migration waves. After your first log-in to IMDS Release 8.0, please use the IMDS Release 8.0 link from the start page for future system usage.

Throughout the migration, our primary and uncompromising goal is to ensure issues are minimized and contained. While we appreciate the desire to move quickly, we will not sacrifice operational integrity to accelerate the transition or maintain intermediate milestones. Any migration dates or schedules we communicate are guidelines based upon our understanding at the time. This information should at no time be perceived as a commitment, and will change as circumstances require.

Please be aware there will be no individual e-mail communication to users and/or IMDS registered companies prior to their migration to IMDS Rel. 8.0.

Please ensure appropriate awareness of IMDS Release 8.0 within your organizations. We encourage all users and especially IMDS company administrators to prepare now.

Our small supplier company was unexpectedly migrated to IMDS Release 8.0. Can we still use Release 7.2? Why didn't we receive information by email that our company would be migrated? It would have been much easier for us if we had known about the migration beforehand... Thanks.



Dear IMDS using company,

We will address your points in order:

- 1. No, once migrated to the new Release 8.0 you cannot continue to use IMDS Release 7.2.
- 2. Sending out e-mails to all users would not guarantee that the users really get the information. This is why we decided to give all information and instructions to the users at their login.
- 3. To the final observation, we offer two points for consideration:
- Users who subscribe to and/or read the IMDS Newsletter have been receiving notification
 and updates regarding the upcoming migration to IMDS 8.0 since January 2013.
 Subscription provides free, automated delivery to your email inbox, and all IMDS users
 are encouraged to subscribe to and read these quarterly publications.
- The schedule and support for the IMDS 8.0 migration is dynamic and constantly improving, as we are learning useful information which modify the migration process at each step, beginning with pre-migration testing even before the early adopter companies began migration at the beginning of June 2013.
